

**MINIMUM & MAXIMUM HEIGHTS**  
**#79-01**

An ordinance to establish the minimum/maximum heights slabs and/or block piers in the construction of buildings.

Section 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River, Louisiana, in legal session convened that the elevation of the top of the slab shall be a minimum of eight (8) inches above the curb, and where no curb exists the elevation of the slab shall be a minimum of eight (8) inches plus six (6) inches.

Section 2: Be it further ordained that the maximum elevation shall be eighteen (18) inches above the curb and where no curb exists the maximum elevation shall not exceed eighteen (18) inches plus six (6) inches.

Section 4: Be it further ordained that all measurements shall be taken from the edge of street directly in front of building.

Section 5: Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage and promulgation.
