

**RAILROAD TANK CARS**  
**#79-11**

An ordinance prohibiting railroad tank cars parking in certain areas of the Town of Pearl River:

Section 1:       Parking of railroad cars currently or immediately previously containing explosives, gasoline or other flammable gases, or other dangerous materials or articles on any main track, spur track or side track within three hundred feet of any building in any area zoned as residential classifications R-1, R-2, or R-3 under the zoning laws and regulations of the Town within the limits of the Town of Pearl River and the parking of railroad cars containing the above mentioned substances is hereby prohibited and the parking empty railroad cars which might have immediately previously contained the substance mentioned in this section is also prohibited.

Section 2:       Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall be in force and effect on this 27th day of November, 1979.

Section 3:       Anyone violating this ordinance will be fined five hundred dollars (\$500) and imprisoned for a long period of sixty days (60).
