

ORDINANCE 2019-02-01

An ordinance relative to the prohibition and keeping of certain animals within the limits of the Town of Pearl River.

WHEREAS, ordinance #95-03 restricting livestock in the Town was adopted in 1995; and

WHEREAS, certain amendments were adopted in 2002 prohibiting the raising of farm animals within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend the above referenced ordinances;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Pearl River that Ordinances #95-03 and #12-02 are hereby rescinded and re-enacted to add Section 11-39 to read as follows:


“Sec. 11-39 Prohibition and keeping of certain animals within the limits of the Town of Pearl River

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep any livestock including, but not limited to, horses, cows, sheep, goats, llamas or swine within the limits of the Town of Pearl River.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to keep a rooster or roosters within the limits of the Town of Pearl River;
- (c) The keeping bees, no more than six (6) chickens, and/or five (5) rabbits within the limits of the Town of Pearl River shall be permitted;
- (d) Creekside Junior High School and Pearl River High School may construct suitable enclosures for the keeping of chickens, roosters, rabbits, pigs, goats, sheep, lambs, horses and cows for students who participate in showing, raising and/or selling of such animals.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
