

TOWN OF PEARL RIVER COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 17, 2023 at 7:00 P.M.

CALL TO ORDER:

The Council Meeting was held at the Pearl River Town Hall and called to order by Mayor Lee at 7:00 p.m.

INVOCATION:

The Invocation was given by Alderman Galloway.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Lee.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Alderman Phillips, Franatovich, Moray, Galloway and Schultheis, along with Mayor Lee, Attorney Mathison, Attorney Daigle and Chief Sessions.

RESOLUTIONS – a. Resolution R23-01-03 – A Resolution confirming Maude Griffis as Town Clerk. Alderman Galloway made a motion to accept; seconded by Alderman Moray. Mayor Lee called for a roll call vote; Alderman Phillips, Yea; Alderman Franatovich, Yea; Alderman Moray, Yea; Alderman Galloway, Yea; Alderman Schultheis, Yea. **All in favor, So moved.**

b. Resolution R23-01-04 - A Resolution appointing Mathieu Daigle as Mayors Court Magistrate. Alderman Schultheis made a motion to accept; seconded by Alderman Moray. Mayor Lee called for a roll call vote; Alderman Phillips, Yea; Alderman Franatovich, Yea; Alderman Moray, Yea; Alderman Galloway, Yea; Alderman Schultheis, Yea. All in favor, So moved.

PUBLIC HEARING ORDINANCE NO 22-12-20 - An ordinance relative to the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget. Mayor Lee: Moving forward with the new administration, anyone with a question or statement will be required sign in. It is our goal to have our meetings on the webpage. Floor open for public discussion.

Mayor Lee: The budget has been revisited. Fixed cost stayed in place. Capt. Dean discussed the budget and the needs of the police department as well as possibly adding a sales tax or millage in 2023 to increase revenue.

Bridgett Bennett -Discussed a millage vs sales tax as well as the line item for the boat launch.

Jessica Hanna – Discussed community donations; adding names to the Veterans Wall; The police dept budget and salaries of Town Hall employees.

Mayor Lee clarified his salary that was previously questioned. The ordinance passed in 2017 outlines the current salaries for the Mayor, Chief of Police and Alderman.

Brian Phillips: Asked about moving funds from the water dept to the police dept; and if there any to monitor business working without an occupational license.

Alderman Galloway: Hopeful that enough income will be generated in the water department to cover the upcoming maintenance expenses without having to raise water rates.

Paul Hurley: Would like to keep local police with local knowledge.

Jessica Hanna: Questioned the following - Blighted properties plans; Beautification funds and Capital Expenditures.
