High Volume: month

Schools, hospital, etc. \$250.00 per

Institutional: month

Light Industrial: \$250.00 per month

Section 2: WATER TAP

Residential: \$125.00

Commercial: Low Volume: \$150.00

High Volume: \$200.00

Institutional: cost based on volume Light Industrial: cost based on volume

Section 3: BILLING

The Town reserves the right to turn the water off for nonpayment of two

consecutive

monthly billings for water and sewer bills.

Section 4: **RECONNECT**

All outstanding bills against property owners must be paid in full, plus a \$10.00

reconnect fee will be charged for reconnecting water.
