

**WATER ORDINANCE
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE
#174-A**

Ordinance number 174-A to include the Water System for the Town of Pearl River:

Section 1: **RATES**

A.) Residential:	\$8.50 plus 4% state tax, monthly, per single family
B.) Commercial:	Low Volume: stores, offices, etc. \$15.00 per month
	High Volume: car wash, laundramat, etc. \$32.00 per month
	Institutional: Schools, hospital, etc. \$250.00 per month
	Light Industrial: \$250.00 per month

Section 2: **WATER TAP**

Residential:	\$125.00
Commercial:	Low Volume: \$150.00
	High Volume: \$200.00
	Institutional: cost based on volume
	Light Industrial: cost based on volume

Section 3: **BILLING**

The Town reserves the right to turn the water off for nonpayment of two consecutive monthly billings for water and sewer bills.

Section 4: **RECONNECT**

All outstanding bills against property owners must be paid in full, plus a \$10.00 reconnect fee will be charged for reconnecting water.

This amendment to Ordinance 174-A to include the water was passed at the April 9, 1996 Town Council meeting with a motion by Alderman Dick Karchner, seconded by Alderman David McQueen
