ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OPENED AND UNSEALED #80-10

The following ordinance prohibiting the sale or removal of opened or unsealed metal or glass alcoholic beverage containers from bars or lounges in the Town of Pearl River, and restricting the consumption of alcoholic beverages from metal or glass containers.

- The removal of any opened or unsealed metal or glass alcoholic beverage container from the premises of any bar or lounge located in the Town of Pearl River is prohibited except for the removal of empty containers in connection with trash and garbage disposal, glass and metal recycling programs, or the exchange of returnable bottles.
- 2. The sales of any alcoholic beverage in an opened or unsealed metal or glass container from a bar or lounge for consumption outside the premises of the bar or lounge is prohibited.
- The consumption of any alcoholic beverage packaged in a metal or glass container is prohibited within 500 feet from the entrance or exit of a bar or lounge.
- 4. The consumption of any alcoholic beverage packaged in a metal or glass container is prohibited on public parking lots within the Town of Pearl River; and all Town streets in the Town of Pearl River.
- 5. Any person found violating section 1,2,3, or 4 of this ordinance shall be fined not more than \$500.00, or not more than 60 days in jail, or both.

This ordinance was adopted this 14th day of October, 1980.
