PROPERTY TAX MILLEAGE #80-11 AMENDED

Ordinance for property taxes for the Town of Pearl River, Louisiana.

- Section 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River, in legal session convenes, that the following millage is hereby levied by the Louisiana State Legislature for the amount of 5.83 mills to remain at this millage until a vote of the people before an increase in millage
- Section 2: Property taxes are due and payable to the Town of Pearl River on the first day of the year and delinquent forty-five days thereafter and subject to a penalty of 10% per annual and 6 % interest.
- Section 3: Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.

Section 5: Be it ordained that on this 17th day of April, 2001, a special election was called for, to be held on July 21, 2001 for a 4.17 property tax millage dedicated for street improvement for 10 years beginning in January 1, 2002. VOTING : YEAS 3 NAYS 0 ABSENT 2 ABSTAIN 0 MOTION CARRIED.

Section 6 : Be it ordained on the 23rd day of July, 2001, the Board of Aldermen at a regular scheduled council meeting hereby do declare the election results official and the 4.17 mills will take effect in January 1, 2002.
