HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION ORDINANCE 82-09

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO PLACING OBSTRUCTION ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF PEARL RIVER AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR SAME BY FINE OR IMPRISONMENT.

SECTION 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River: That all highways within the Town of Pearl River shall be kept clear of any and all obstructions at least three (3) feet from the outside edge of such highway.

SECTION 2: Be it further ordained etc. that after due notice by the Police Chief to clear such obstruction twenty-four (24) hours grace will be allowed after which time the Chief shall prepare the proper affidavit.

SECTION 3: Corner Lot: A required open space unoccupied and unobstructed by any structure or portion of a structure from thirty (30) inches above the general ground level of the graded lot upward, provided however, that fence and walls may be permitted in any yard subject to height limitations as indicated herein.

SECTION 4: Corner-Lot Front: A yard extending between side lot lines across the front of a lot. In any required front, <u>NO FENCE OR WALL</u> shall be permitted which materially impedes vision across such a yard above the height of (30) inches, and no hedge or other vegetation shall be permitted which materially impedes vision across such a yard between the height of (30) inches and (10) feet.

SECTION 5: Footage shall be measured from the intersecting intersection lines (edge of pavement) There shall be a (30) foot unobstructed area as described in Section 4.

SECTION 6: Be it further ordained that whoever violates the Provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not more than Five Hundred (\$500.00) dollars, or shall be confined for not more than Sixty (60) days or both.

SECTION 7: Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage and promulgation by unanimous vote on September 28, 1982.
