

ORDINANCE #83-02

AN ORDINANCE PEFERRING TO THE OPERATION OF ANY COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENT IN THE
TOWN OF PEARL RIVER

Section 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River, La. In legal session convened that any commercial establishment serving alcoholic beverages upon occasion of having a band for entertainment or special activity: is required to hire, at the establishment's expense a uniformed police officer or other officer commissioned by the Town of Perl River or St. Tammany Parish in order to maintain adequate control during such activities.

Section 1-A: The decision to hire one or more officers will be left to the discretion of the police chief.

Section 2: Be it further ordained that any persons found in violation of this ordinance shall upon conviction be sentenced to pay a fine: not to exceed (\$500.00) five hundred dollars or be imprisoned for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days; or both; at the discretion of the court.

Section 3: Now, therefore be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River in legal session convened on February 22 1983 this ordinance be declared passed and adopted.
