BINGO, ETC. ORDINANCE #86-11

An ordinance for the Town of Pearl River, Louisiana, relative to charitable raffles, bingo and keno license and providing for the insurance of permits therefore.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Perl River, State of Louisiana:

SECTION 1: No raffles, bingo, keno or like games shall be conducted in the Town of Pearl River without first obtaining a license from the Town Clerk.

SECTION 2: Any applicant for a Town license to operate a raffle, bingo keno or like games of chance shall comply with Louisiana revised statutes 33:4861.1 et. seq.

SECTION 3: Licenses shall pay to the Town the sum of \$500.00 annually for the issuance of such license hereunder payable in advance upon initial issuance of said license.

SECTION 4: Parties found in violation of this ordinance shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith or contrary hereto are hereby repealed.
