

Ordinance #91-02

UNLICENSED MOTOR VEHICLE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen in regular session, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to operate any unlicensed motor vehicle, three-wheelers, four-wheelers, go carts, tricycles, skateboards, roller skates, scooters, and improper use of bicycles in the streets of Pearl River.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that penalties are set as follows:

First Offense:	Twenty-Dollar Fine
Second Offense:	Forty-Dollar Fine
Third Offense:	Seventy-Dollar Fine
Fourth Offense:	Up to Five-Hundred Dollars and/or 60 Days in jail or both

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the intention of this ordinance is not for a money making revenue, but a safety precaution for our children.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this shall go into effect immediately after its passage and promulgation.

This ordinance made by resolution by Alderman Pat Walsh, second by Alderman David McQueen by unanimous vote.
