

BURIAL IN TOWN CEMETERY

AN ORDINANCE CREATING PERMISSION FOR BURIAL IN THE TOWN CEMETERY.

Whereas, permission for burial in the cemetery shall be at the sole discussion of the Town; and,

Section 1: Because the Town is providing a burial plot at no cost, the person making application must demonstrate a need for this service; and,

Section 2: As each burial is completed, the Town shall have completed its commitment to any and all surviving family members; and,

Section 3: However, if, at the time of burial the spouse of the deceased requests a plot next to deceased, the Town may respond in the following manner; and,

Section 4: The Town will mark the cemetery map to indicate our intention not to use this plot until all other plots in the cemetery have been used; and,

Section 5: If the surviving spouse dies prior to the time all unmarked plots have been filled, then the Town will bury the deceased side by side with his/her spouse.

Therefore, be it ordained, that the above requirements for burial are enforced by this ordinance with a motion by Alderman Pat Walsh, and a second be Alderman David McQueen, and adopted at a regular Town Council meeting on July 23, 1991 with a vote as follows:
