TRUCK ROUTE & LOAD LIMIT #91-06

Be it enacted by the mayor and Town Council of the Town of Pearl River, Louisiana, Parish of St. Tammany, in legal session convened:

Truck Route:	This ordinance was amended and adopted on May 28, 1991. A motion was made by Cherokee Klusener, seconded by Marjorie Taylor. Voting: 4 YEAS 0 NAYS 1 ABSENT
Motion Carried:	Second Amendment: This ordinance was amended and adopted on April 14, 1992. A motion made by David McQueen seconded by Pat Walsh.
Voting:	 4 YEAS 0 NAYS 1 ABSENT (Klusener) To establish a truck route for the Town of Pearl River, making Hwy 41 Spur41 bypass and Hwy 3081 (Old Hwy 11) established truck routes, and shall be posted as such. No road, street, avenue, boulevard, alley, etc, shall be used, transversed, or occupied by a truck or other vehicle of similar nature over the load capacity of three tons, except for local deliveries, and for which no other truck route exists. Owners and drivers will be allowed to take their empty trucks home after work, but not to exceed a 15 ton load limit per vehicle. Whoever violates the provisions of this article shall be fined not more than \$500 plus costs, or shall be confined for not more than 60 days, or both. This ordinance replaces any/and all previous ordinances or agreements and is effective immediately after its passage and promulgation.
