

TRAINS BLOCKING CROSSINGS

#91-11

An ordinance to require railroad trains operation within the limits of the Town of Pearl River to cut said trains at street crossings where ever said crossings shall remain blocked for more than (10) minutes and to provide a penalty for the violation of the same.

Section 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River that hereafter it shall be unlawful for any railroad company through its officers, agents, or employees to allow trains to blockade any public crossings in the Town of Pearl River for a longer period than ten (10) minutes.

Section 2: Be it further ordained etc. that any officer, agent, or employee of any railroad company who shall be guilty of violating this ordinance shall be fined in a sum of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) or be imprisoned in the Town Jail for not less than sixty (60) days or both; at the discretion of the court.

Section 3: Be it further ordained etc. that this ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of passage.
