

Wrecker Ordinance
ORDINANCE #92-04

An ordinance for the Town of Pearl River, LA. for establishing policy and regulations regarding wrecker services operating within city limits.

The Pearl River Police Department shall not engage the services of any person, firm, corporation or other entity in connection with the towing, removal or storage of any wrecked, abandoned, disabled or designated motor vehicle unless that person, firm, corporation or other entity has been authorized by the Chief of the Pearl River Police Department to provide such services in accordance with this ordinance.

Section 1: Authorization: General Requirements All Applicants for Authorization
Shall:

A.) Adhere to all laws of the State of Louisiana, as outlined in the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections "Towing, recovery and storage rules and regulations". Including titles 32 and 47 concerning maximum speed limits, lighting requirements, brake requirements, tow truck equipment, required warning devices, vehicle and driver's license and vehicle storage requirements and records. This ordinance was introduced at the March 24, 1992 regular Town Council meeting by Alderman Cherokee Klusener and approved and adopted at the regular Town Council meeting of April 14, 1992 with a motion by Alderman David McQueen, seconded by Alderman Pat Walsh.

This ordinance goes into effect immediately upon its passage and supersedes any/and all other ordinances pertaining to wrecker services.
