An ordinance restricting livestock in the Town of Pearl River, Parish of St. Tammany, State of Louisiana.

Section 1: Be it ordained that it shall be unlawful for any person to keep any livestock including, but not limited to horses, cows, sheep, goats, lamas, swine, which also includes potbellied pigs, etc. within corporate limits of the Town of Pearl River.

Section 2: Be it further ordained that it shall be unlawful for any person to raise any farm animals (such as bees, chickens, ducks, geese, quail, guinea, peacock, rabbits, and etc.) within the corporate limits of the Town of Perl River.

Section 3: Be it further ordained that whoever violates the provisions of this ordinance may be fined not less than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars, no more than five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or shall be confined for not more than sixty days (60) or both.

Section 4: This amended ordinance becomes effective immediately upon adoption.
