## PARK #95-04 AMENDED

An ordinance for the Town of Pearl River for establishing rules and regulations for the Town Park.

In order to have a playground available for everyone to enjoy

Section 1: and minimize vandalism,

park rules are set forth herein:

Park will be open to the public, daily from 8a.m. to dark. Dark

Section 2: is described as half an

hour after the official sunset.

Section 3: Signs shall be erected stating;

NO ANIMALS, ALCOHOL, CUSSING, BICYCLES, GLASS

CONTAINERS, LOUD MUSIC,

ROUGH HOUSING, LITTERING, PETS, OR

DESTRUCTIVE BEHAVIOR.

Children under six (6) years of age must have adult

Section 4: supervision. Adults will be held

responsible for the conduct of their children.

Any person repeatedly breaking the rules listed in Section 3

can be banned and subject

to a fine. In the event of a minor, the parent can be fined

the following:

1st offense- Warning, verbal from any Town

employee

2nd offense- \$50.00 3rd offense- \$100.00

then, fined \$500.00 and /or 60 days in jail, or both.

Section 6: PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PARK!

Due to the unsafe and unsanitary conditions of having pets in

the park, pets are not

allowed, and the owner can be fined in accordance to this

ordinance.

All activities (parties) should be scheduled at the Town Hall.

Section 7: Town residents considered

first.
